

Transfer Advising Sheet for Computer Information Systems Program

Florida State College at Jacksonville
Associate of Arts, Associate of Science, or Associate of Applied Science Degree

Articulated Program with Strayer University
Bachelor of Science in Information Systems Degree

This transfer institution has agreed to accept the specified associate's degree from Florida State College at Jacksonville. The Florida State College at Jacksonville graduate will be accepted at the junior level, and is required to complete the equivalent of two years of full-time coursework to complete the specified bachelor's degree.

It is very important to make sure that your Program of Study at Florida State College at Jacksonville is Associate of Arts, Associate of Science, or Associate of Applied Science Degree. If you do not plan to transfer to this specific transfer institution, please follow the Program of Study, as specified in the College Catalog.

Upon graduation from Florida State College at Jacksonville, Strayer University (SU) will accept up to 64 semester hours from any AA, AS, or AAS degree towards the BS. Students will complete a minimum of 54 upper-division quarter hours from Strayer University to graduate with a Bachelor of Science in Information Systems degree.

General Education Notes:

- AA and AS graduates will be considered to have satisfied all lower division general education requirements for Strayer University. AAS graduates may be required to complete additional lower division general education requirements upon transferring.
- Please review the Florida State College at Jacksonville Catalog for General Education Requirements (GER).
- CLAS (College Level Academic Skills): Satisfaction of these skills is a graduation requirement for the associate in arts degree in the state college system of Florida. Students must meet one of the approved exemptions – see the catalog for more information.
- The state university Foreign Language Requirement does not apply to students transferring to Strayer University.
- All General Education courses require a grade of “C” or above.

Prerequisite and Elective Notes:

- All prerequisite courses require a grade of “C” or above.
- A major prerequisite course may satisfy both Florida State College at Jacksonville General Education Requirements and SU Major Prerequisites. Please review the General Education Requirements and talk with an advisor.
- Electives must have the appropriate AA (for AA degree students), AS (for AS degree students), or AAS (for AAS degree students) notation at the end of the course description in Florida State College at Jacksonville catalog.

Other Notes:

- Students must complete the Information Literacy Assessment requirement prior to graduation from Florida State College at Jacksonville.
- The entire associates degree will be transferred in to SU regardless of the number of credit hours, into a related degree program at SU. The only limit on the number of transferable credit hours is the total number of hours required for the specific associates degree program from Florida State College at Jacksonville. This number will vary per program. For example, the AA degree currently requires 60 credit hours, and that is the maximum number of hours that SU will accept by a Florida State College at Jacksonville transfer student. The AS Business Administration degree currently requires 64 credit hours, and that is the maximum number of hours that SU will accept by a Florida State College at Jacksonville transfer student. The AS Nursing degree currently requires 72 credit hours, and that is the maximum number of hours that SU will accept by a Florida State College at Jacksonville transfer student.
- Students who have completed or will complete an AA, AS, or AAS degree by the time they transfer to SU will be exempted from paying the SU application fee.
- AA, AS and AAS graduates, who have earned at least 24 semester hours of transferable course work at Florida State College at Jacksonville, and have a Florida State College at Jacksonville GPA of at least 2.0, are guaranteed admission to SU.
- SU will evaluate Prior Learning Activity for Credit Evaluation and other life experiences for possible credit.
- If you do not plan to transfer to this specific transfer institution, please follow the Program of Study, as specified in the College Catalog.
