General Education Notes:

- Please review the Florida Community College Catalog for General Education Requirements (GER).
- CLAST (College Level Academic Skills Test): The CLAST is a graduation requirement for the associate in arts degree in the community college system of Florida. Passing all four subsets of the CLAST exam, or satisfying a CLAST exemption, is a requirement for meeting the associate of arts degree graduation requirement.
- Foreign Language: All Bachelor of Arts majors in the College of Arts and Sciences must complete the foreign language requirement prior to graduating from UNF. This requirement must be satisfied even if two (2) years of foreign language were completed at the high school level. Foreign language courses must be completed with grades of “C” or above. Students are encouraged to complete the foreign language requirement at FCCJ.
- All General Education courses require a grade of “C” or above.

Prerequisite and Elective Notes:

- All prerequisite courses require a grade of “C” or above.
- A major prerequisite course may satisfy both FCCJ General Education Requirements and UNF Major Prerequisites. Please review the General Education Requirements and talk with an advisor.
- Electives must have AA notation at the end of the course description in FCCJ catalog.

Other Notes:

- Qualified students will have earned a grade point average of 2.0 and will have completed a minimum of 60 semester hours before transferring.
- No more than 64 semester hours of credit may be transferred toward completion of the degree requirements at FC.
- If you do not plan to transfer to this specific transfer institution, please follow the Program of Study, as specified in the College Catalog.
