This transfer institution has agreed to accept the specified associate's degree from Florida State College at Jacksonville. The Florida State College at Jacksonville graduate will be accepted at the junior level, and is required to complete the equivalent of two years of full-time coursework to complete the specified bachelor's degree.

It is very important to make sure that your Program of Study at Florida State College at Jacksonville is Associate of Science in Environmental Science Degree. If you do not plan to transfer to this specific transfer institution, please follow the Program of Study, as specified in the Florida State College at Jacksonville Catalog.

Upon graduation from Florida State College at Jacksonville, University of Maryland University College (UMUC) will accept up to 70 credits from AS Environmental Science degree towards the BS Environmental Management, and a total of 90 semester hours from all sources combined (such as American Council on Education recommended credit and credit for prior learning). Students will complete a minimum of 30 semester credit hours from University of Maryland University College towards the bachelor's degree. Students will typically complete 64 semester credit hours at Florida State College at Jacksonville and 56 semester credit hours at UMUC to total 120 semester credit hours. The UMUC bachelors' degree programs require a minimum of 120 semester credit hours.

General Education Notes:

- Please review the Florida State College at Jacksonville Catalog for General Education Requirements (GER).
- CLAS (College Level Academic Skills): Satisfaction of these skills is a graduation requirement for the associate in arts degree in the state college system of Florida. Students must meet one of the approved exemptions – see the catalog for more information. The CLAS graduation requirement does not apply to the associate of science degree student transferring to University of Maryland University College.
- The state university Foreign Language Requirement does not apply to students transferring to University of Maryland University College.
- All General Education courses require a grade of “C” or above.
- Students will need to satisfy the UMUC general education requirements (the UMUC general education program requires more credits than the Florida State College at Jacksonville general education program, so additional general education courses will be required upon transfer).

Prerequisite and Elective Notes:

- All prerequisite courses require a grade of “C” or above.
- A major prerequisite course may satisfy both Florida State College at Jacksonville General Education Requirements and UMUC General Education Requirements. Please review the General Education Requirements and talk with an advisor.

Other Notes:

- All courses must be completed with a grade of “C” or above to be accepted as transfer credit at UMUC.
- Students must complete the Information Literacy Assessment requirement prior to graduation from Florida State College at Jacksonville.
- A minimum of 30 semester hours must be completed at UMUC.
- No more than 70 semester hours of credit from Florida State College at Jacksonville may be transferred toward completion of the degree requirements at UMUC.
- If you do not plan to transfer to this specific transfer institution, please follow the Program of Study, as specified in the Florida State College at Jacksonville College Catalog.
